le: Paul gathering firewood when he is bit by a snake (Acts 28:2-3)

B. Exercise initiative to take the first step toward reconciliation.

Matthew 5:23-24 and Matthew 18:15-

It is always your move to bring about reconciliation.

C. Exercise initiative in seeking knowledge

Proverbs 20:5 Counsel in the heart of man is like deep water; but a man of understanding will draw it out.

Leaders are not afraid to try new and different things. God is creative by nature.

How do you gain a creative spirit?

A. Train yourself to think. "If it works now, will it soon be obsolete?"

B. Pray for the boldness and courage it will take to try something new when God reveals it to you.

C. Invest much time in fellowship with the One who is the most creative person in the whole universe.

We must be willing to break new ground and step out of the established mold.
